The undersigned is informed and believes that:

COUNT 1

On or about December 5, 2010, defendant(s) NIKOLAS E. did commit a felony namely: HAVING A CONCEALED FIREARM ON THE PERSON, a violation of Section 12025(a)(2) of the Penal Code of the State of California, County of Solano, in that said defendant did unlawfully carry concealed upon the person a pistol, revolver, and firearm capable of being concealed upon the person.

It is further alleged that the firearm and unexpended ammunition were in the immediate possession of, and readily accessible to, the defendant and that the firearm was not registered to the defendant.

It is further alleged that the defendant, did commit acts which aggravate the above crime(s) pursuant to Rules 4.408 and 4.421 of the California Rules of Court.

DISCOVERY REQUEST PURSUANT TO PENAL CODE SECTION 1054/1054.7:

Pursuant to Penal Code sections 1054 through 1054.7, the People request that, within fifteen (15) days, the defendant and/or his/her attorney disclose: (a) The names and addresses of persons, other than the defendant, he/she intends to call as witnesses at trial, together with any relevant written or recorded statements of experts made in connection with the case, and including the results of physical or mental examinations, scientific tests, experiments, or comparisons which the defendant intends to offer in evidence at the trial.
