The District Attorney of Solano County alleges that:

COUNT 1

On or about July 11, 2009, defendant(s) PARRISH S did commit a felony namely: CRIMINAL THREATS, a violation of Section 422 of the Penal Code of the State of California, County of Solano, in that said defendant did willfully and unlawfully threaten to commit a crime which would result in death and great bodily injury to S. S., with the specific intent that the statement be taken as a threat.

"NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code section 1192.7(c)."

It is further alleged that the threatened crime, on its face and under the circumstances in which it was made, was so unequivocal, unconditional, immediate and specific as to convey to S. S. a gravity of purpose and an immediate prospect of execution.

It is further alleged that the said S. S. was reasonably in sustained fear of his/her safety and the safety of his/her immediate family.


